

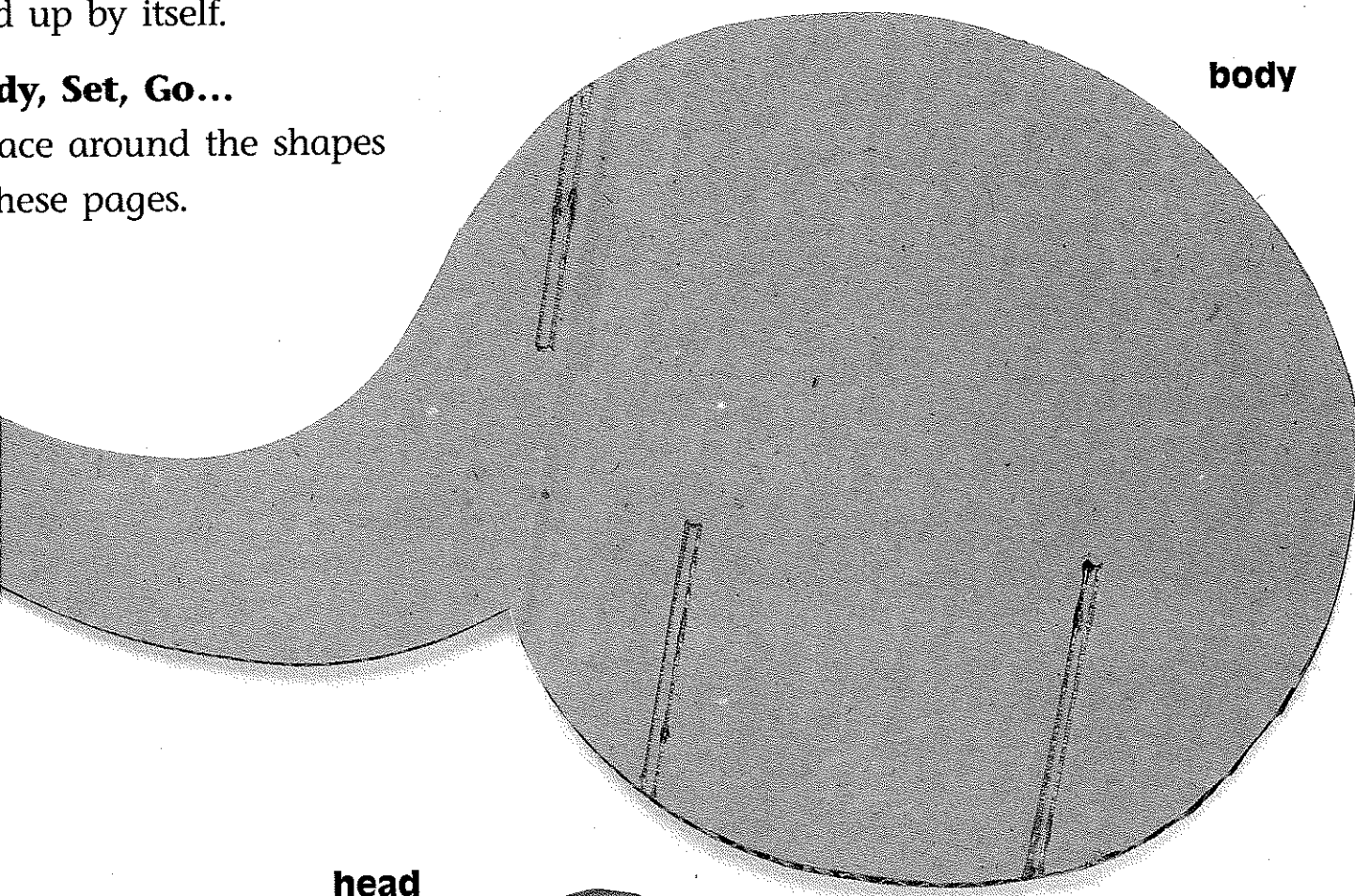
# Animal Magic

is a way to turn flat pieces of cardboard into an elephant that will stand up by itself.

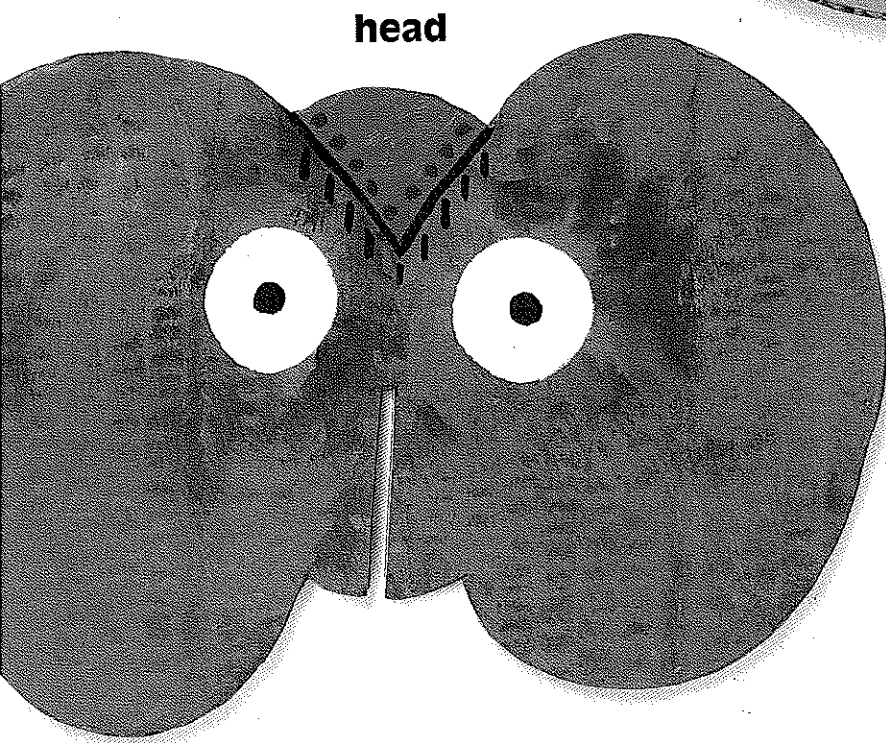
## Ready, Set, Go...

Place around the shapes on these pages.

2. Tape your traces to pieces of thick cardboard and cut out the shapes.

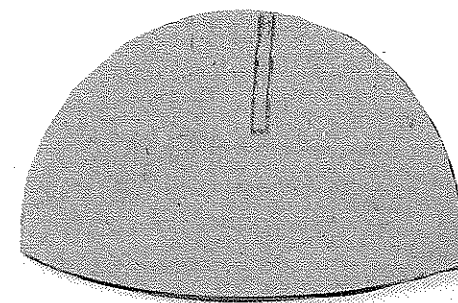

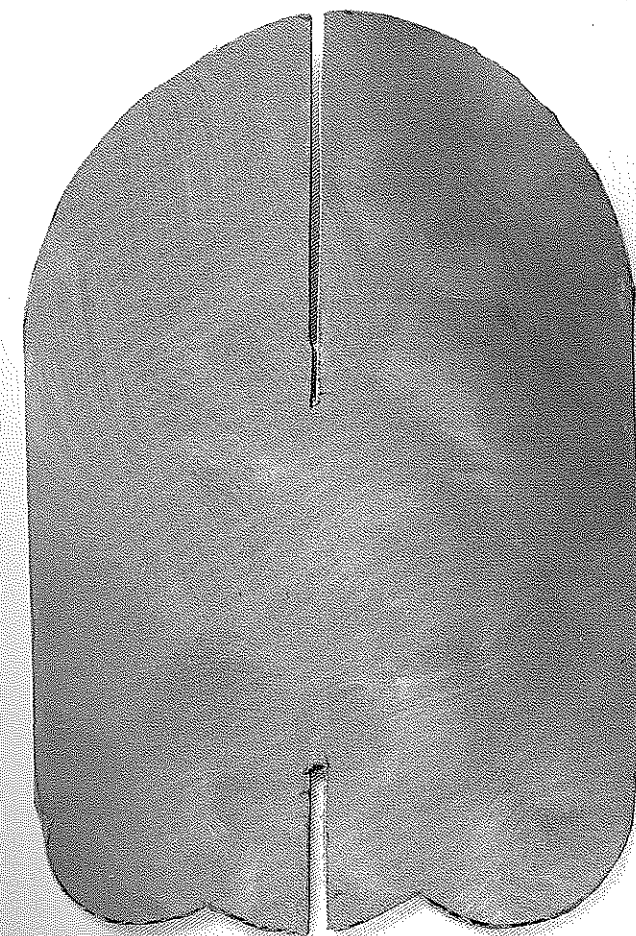
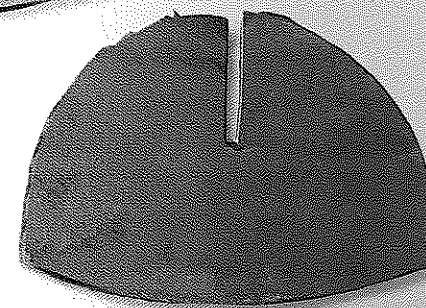
3. To make a complete elephant, you'll need one body, one head, two legs, and two feet.  
4. Ask a grown-up to help you cut some narrow slits in your shapes. Look at the pictures here to see where to make the slits.

5. Paint the pieces of your elephant gray and leave them to dry. If you don't have any gray paint, make some by mixing black and white together.

6. Slot the feet into the slits at the bottom of the leg shapes.

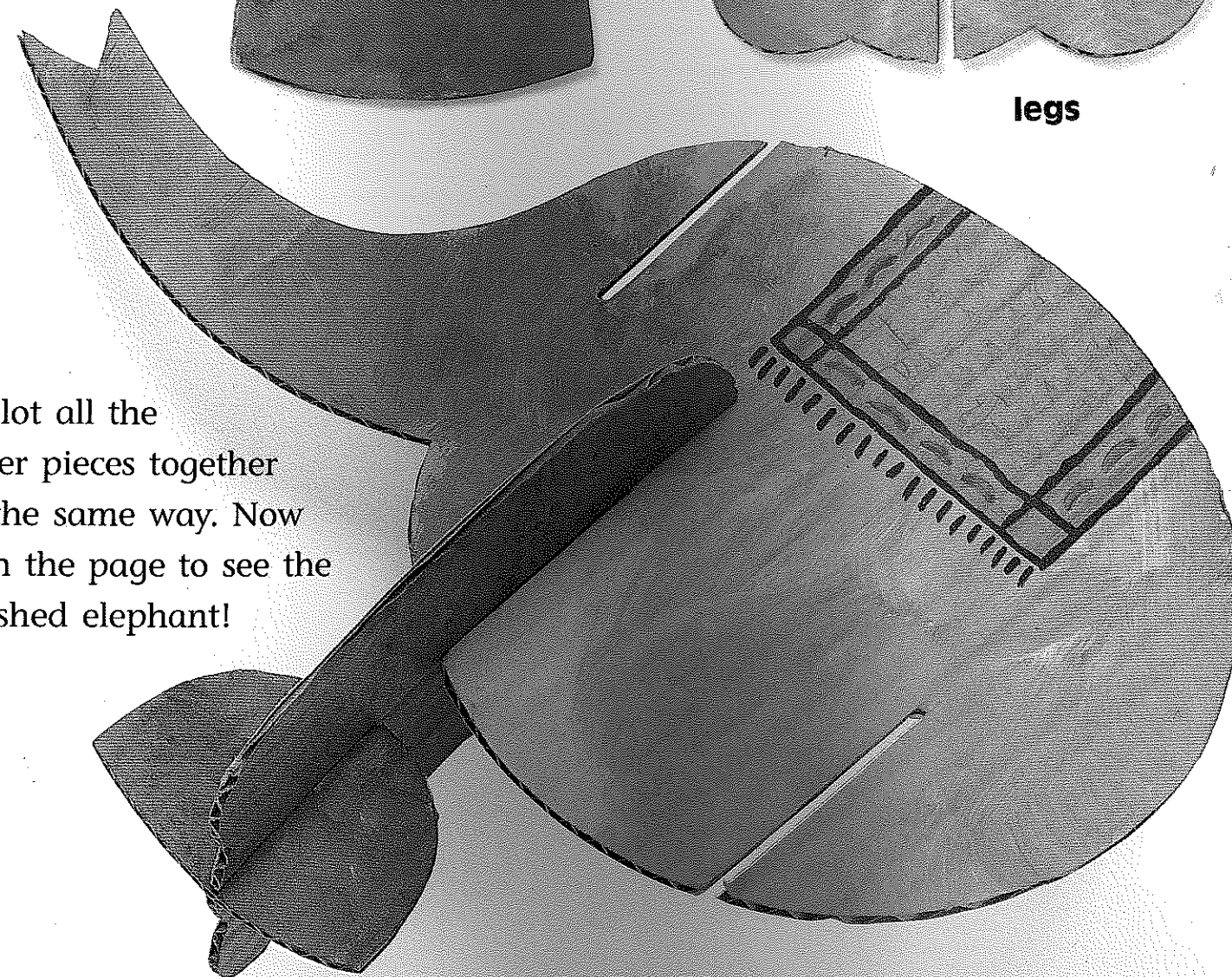

7. Slot all the other pieces together in the same way. Now turn the page to see the finished elephant!
